Born and raised in Maywood, Illinois, Michael Finley developed his passion for basketball. In 2007, Finley was voted one of the 100 Legends of the IH-SA Boys Basketball Tournament, recognizing his superior performance. He averaged 20 points per game and finished his college career as the all-time leading scorer with 2,100 points at the University of Wisconsin. Michael graduated from Wisconsin with a Bachelor of Science in Business

In 1995, the Phoenix Suns drafted Michael in the first round. He was named to the First Team All-Rookie squad following his rookie campaign with the Suns. Finley enjoyed a successful career in Dallas, TX for the Mavericks from 1996 to 2005 after which he signed with the San Antonio

Spurs. Finley is a two time NBA All-Star and won the 2007 NBA Championship as a member of the Spurs. Michael played professional basketball for 15 years and retired in 2010. He currently works as a player development coach for the Dallas Mavericks and resides in the metroplex with his wife and three children.

What is the G.I.F.T.4.S. program goals?

To provide students and their families with fundamental skills and tools to achieve their personal and professional objectives. The Michael Finley Foundation (TMFF) will focus on implementing the 3-week G.I.F.T.4.S. program at no cost to its participants. The program will begin with approximately fifteen to twenty-five 3rd grade students and their families.

Families will commit to parent education classes once a week. The classes consist of parenting skills, study skills, bullying, and other programs. Each year TMFF will add additional 3rd grade students. The students will participate in the program until high school graduation.

Each participant upon graduation from high

school will receive either a scholarship for a continuing education program of their choice or start up money towards their choice of career.

What is the G.I.F.T.4.S. program's strengths?

To provide participants access to qualified teachers, counselors, coaches, volunteers, and staff. Together, they will achieve a high level of excellence. TMFF will continuously measure academic achievement of student and family involvement in the school as well as the community.
